

WITHDRAWAL AND COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS (Project for 1420, boulevard du Mont-Royal)

Notice is given of the results of the registration process held on June 22, 2010, pertaining to the By-law concerning the conversion and occupancy for housing purposes of the building located at 1420, Boulevard du Mont-Royal (Group A) (09-003-1) and to the By-law concerning the conversion and occupancy for housing purposes of the building located at 1420, Boulevard du Mont-Royal (Group A) (09-003-2), adopted by city council on June 14, 2010:

 The number of qualified voters who signed the register pertaining to By-law 09003-1 was of 278, where 224 were required in order to request that a referendum poll be held.

At its August 23, 2010 meeting, city council decided to withdraw By-law 09-003-1.

 The number of qualified voters who signed the register pertaining to to By-law 09-003-2 was 32, where 192 were required in order to request that a referendum poll be held.

In accordance with section 554 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities (R.S.Q. chapter E-2.2), By-law 09-003-2 is deemed approved by qualified voters

Notice is also given that, at its August 23, 2010 meeting, city council adopted Bylaw 09-003, entitled "Règlement autorisant la transformation et l'occupation à des fins d'habitation du bâtiment situé au 1420 boulevard du Mont-Royal" [By-law concerning the conversion and occupancy for housing purposes of the building located at 1420, Boulevard du Mont-Royal]. This by-law comprises all the provisions of the second draft By-law 09-003, adopted at the council's February 22, 2010 meeting, which were not subject to approval by way of a referendum.

By-laws 09-003 and 09-003-2 come into force on September 2, 2010 and may be consulted at the Direction du greffe, at 275, Rue Notre-Dame Est. They may also be consulted anytime at: www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
