PUBLIC CONSULTATION

BY-LAW CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF BUILDINGS AGAINST SEWAGE BACK-UP (P-11-010)

That draft by-law was adopted, by resolution (CM11 0378), at the city council meeting of May 16, 2011 (session of May 17).

In accordance with section 125 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (R.S.Q., chapter A-19.1), the mayor has designated Bernard Blanchet, chairman of the standing committee on economic and urban development and housing, to hold a public consultation.

At that meeting, Mr Blanchet will review the draft by-law. All persons and organizations wishing to express their views should register within 30 minutes of the meeting, or register in advance with the Direction du greffe at 514-872-3770.

Persons with reduced mobility may use the west side entrance (Place Vauquelin).

The council chamber room is equipped with an auditory assistance system. If you are using headsets, tune in to 100.3 FM for clear coverage. Interpretation services are provided, on request, to persons with a hearing disability, subject to the availability of interpreters.

OBJECT OF BY-LAW

The draft by-law will apply to new buildings, buildings where plumbing works alterations are being made and buildings previously affected by flooding or sewage back-up. The by-law states the required protection measures (installation of catch bassin, sump pump and check-valves) in addition to the technical specifications to ensure the quality of work performed by building professionals or individuals.

The by-law is not subject to a referendum vote.
