Public consultation notice

Notice is given to persons interested in the draft by-law titled:

By-law concerning the construction and conversion of buildings

At its meeting of June 20, 2011 (session of June 21), city council adopted, by resolution CM11 0527, the draft by-law titled By-law concerning the construction and conversion of buildings (P-11-018).

In accordance with section 125 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (R.S.Q., chapter A-19.1), a public information meeting will be held by M. Bernard Blanchet, chairman of the standing committee on economic and urban development and housing, as designated by the mayor.

During this meeting, M. Blanchet will explain the draft by-law and will hear the persons and organizations wishing to provide their input. Accessibility

Persons with reduced mobility may use the west side entrance (Place Vauquelin). The room is equipped with a hearing aid system that can be accessed by tuning in to 100.3 FM on your portable player. Moreover, an interpretation service for persons with a hearing impairment is available on request, subject to the availability of interpreters.

Object of the draft by-law

The draft by-law aims to harmonize the construction standards on city territory and to establish common administrative rules with respect to work inspection permits. It clarifies the objects under city council and borough council powers. It integrates various provisions regarding construction, currently scattered in other by-laws. It ensures the consistency and coherence with the By-law concerning the sanitation, maintenance and safety of dwelling units (03-096).

This draft by-law does not include any provision specific to a by-law subject to approval by referendum.
