PUBLIC MEETING

*Sharing Montréal's cycling path network:
With whom and how?*

Following a citizen request, the committee on transportation and public works will consult the population of Montréal with regard to the topic of sharing the city's cycling path network. In this case, the first session will be reserved for the presentation of technical information characterizing the city's cycling path network and its users. Representatives of the *Division des transports actifs et collectifs*, of the city's *Direction des transports*, will carry out this presentation, which will provide the public with an opportunity to formulate questions for the experts. Following the presentation, three sessions will be held, during which the public will be heard and comments and briefs will be received. The last session scheduled on the 2011 calendar will be reserved for the adoption of the committee's recommendations, as the case may be.
