Any person having an interest may file an application for an administrative review of an entry on that roll, as provided for in division I of chapter X of the *Act respecting municipal taxation* (R.S.Q., chapter F-2.1), on the ground that the assessor did not alter the roll as required under the act.

To be admissible, applications for an administrative review must meet the following conditions:

- . Be filed in the fiscal year during which an event justifying an alteration to the roll occurs or in the next fiscal year, if the assessor does not make the alteration.
- . Be submitted on the prescribed form available at the addresses below and at any city point of service.
- . Include the amount under the by-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal for the applicable fiscal year.
- . <u>Be filed in person with the Direction de l'évaluation foncière</u> of the city of Montréal, at one of the addresses below, Monday through Friday, from 9 a.m. to noon, and 1 to 4 p.m.
