



OPENING OF A REGISTER

TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAMES ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST FOR THE ENTIRE CÔTE-DES-NEIGES—NOTRE-DAME-DE-GRÂCE BOROUGH

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that:

1. The Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council, at its meeting held on January 16, 2012, adopted the following by-laws :

- ***By-law authorizing a \$2,100,000 loan for repair work and the protection of buildings (RCA12 17197);***
- ***By-law authorizing a \$3,082,000 loan to acquire vehicles and associated equipment (RCA12 17198).***

2. The two loans shall be a burden on all ratepayers of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough.

3. Qualified voters entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may request that by-laws ***RCA12 17197*** and ***RCA12 17198*** be submitted to a referendum poll by entering their name, address and capacity, together with their signature, in either of the two separate registers open for this purpose for these two by-laws.

4. The conditions that must be met to be considered a qualified voter entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may be obtained from the Borough Office, located at 5160 Décarie, Suite 600, during normal office hours, i.e. from Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4:30 p.m.

5. The register will be open from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., from Monday, February 20, 2012 to Thursday, February 23, 2012, at the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Accès Montréal office, located at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground floor.

6. The number of signatures needed to require that a referendum poll be held is 2354 for each of by-laws. If this number is not reached, the by-law(s) will be deemed approved by qualified voters.

7. To sign the register, qualified voters entitled to have their names entered on the referendum list must establish their identity by presenting their health-insurance card, driver's licence or Canadian passport.

8. The results of the registration process will be announced in the room where the registration is held, on Thursday, February 23, 2012, at 7 p.m. or as soon as they are available.

9. The by-laws may be consulted at the Accès Montréal Office, at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground floor, from Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. and on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
