

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 26, 2012:

RCG 12-001 **Règlement autorisant la construction et l'occupation d'un immeuble destiné à du logement social et situé sur un emplacement sis dans la cour de l'école Marie-Anne portant le numéro 100, rue Sauvé Est, à l'angle Sud-Ouest de la rue Laverdure**
[By-law authorizing the construction and occupancy for social housing purposes of an immovable located in the school yard of Marie-Anne school, bearing number 100, rue Sauvé Est, on the south-west corner of Rue Laverdure]

RCG 07-029-6 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les subventions relatives aux bâtiments industriels (Programme réussir@Montréal - Industrie) (RCG 07-029)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for industrial buildings (Programme réussir@Montréal - Industrie) (RCG 07-029)]
The object is to include in the definition of "industrial activity" greenhouse crops on the rooftop of a building.

RCG 12-003 **Règlement sur le Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal**
[By-law concerning the Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal]
This by-law establishes the powers and responsibilities of the Service de Sécurité incendie de Montréal (SIM). It prescribes the minimum essential standards including those regarding smoke alarms and protection and rescue equipment. It also identifies high risk activities requiring prior authorization by the director, as well as safety procedures to be followed for special events.

The by-laws come into force February 1, 2012, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Direction du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
