### Cultural quarters – Adoption of recommendations

The standing committee on culture, heritage and sports will hold a public meeting for the adoption of recommendations regarding the Cultural quarters.

Following 6 public consultations held during the fall of 2011, during which citizens, organizations and partners participated in great numbers and tabled more than 60 briefs, thus showing their interest in the consolidation and development of the Cultural quarters, the committee will publicly present its recommendations on **Wednesday, April 25, 2012, at 7 p.m.**

The Cultural quarters project is a priority, as outlined in the 2007-2017 Action Plan—Montréal Cultural Metropolis. It aims to enhance Montrealers' cultural quality of life. Culture, in this project, is a broad notion, since cultural quarters are diverse urban areas adapted to local colors. They integrate elements related to heritage, architecture, the environment, arts, sciences and commercial activity, and involve a diverse range of contributors from a wide array of fields.
