PUBLIC MEETING

*Crossing the street:
How to improve pedestrian safety and comfort ?*

The standing committee on transportation and public works will consult the city's population concerning the issue of street crossings. The approach, as promoted by the *Direction des transports de la Ville de Montréal* to analyze the population's needs and expectations and to look for solutions aiming to review pedestrian crossings, will be presented by agents from the *Division de la sécurité et de l'aménagement du réseau artériel* during a first public meeting. Technical information regarding mobility and pedestrian safety will also be presented. Moreover, an overview of practices in this area will provide a summary of potential measures to be considered (legal and normative considerations, layout and behavior adjustments, etc.) This meeting will provide the public with the opportunity to address the experts with their questions and opinions regarding the proposed approaches.

The public consultation will continue in 2013 with a presentation of measures proposed by the *Direction des transports* and the receipt of briefs from citizens and various organizations.
