Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council, at its regular meeting scheduled for 7 p.m. on November 5, 2012, at 5151, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine, Montréal, will rule on an application for a minor exemption relating to the prescribed heights for certain elements on the roof of the new Pavilion K of the Jewish General Hospital, at 3755, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine.

This minor exemption would make it possible to authorize the construction of elements on the roof and of chimneys and the installation of service equipment on the roof of the new Pavilion K, notwithstanding article 12 of specific proposal PP-58 authorizing the construction of a new critical care pavilion (K) and an associated medical clinic for the Jewish General Hospital, located at 3755, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine, under the *By-law on specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable* (RCA02 17017), which stipulates that no construction related to Pavilion K is to exceed the altimetric measurement of Pavilion E.
