Review of municipal action for the improvement of sanitation of dwelling units

The standing committee on economic and urban development and housing will proceed with a public examination of the review of municipal action for the improvement of sanitation of dwelling units over the past five years.

This public study will allow for an overview of the action taken by the *Direction de l'habitation et des arrondissements pour la salubrité des logements* as well as of the regional action plan against bed bugs and of the rooming house pilot project.
