### Public study

Review of the city's accomplishments with respect to universal accessibility for the years 2009 to 2011

The standing committee on social development and diversity in the city will carry out a public study of the review of the city's accomplishments in terms of universal accessibility for 2009 to 2011.

The study will provide the opportunity for the *Direction de la diversité sociale* (social diversity department) to present the main accomplishments in terms of universal accessibility across the 19 boroughs and 17 central units. Following the presentation, the standing committee will accept comments from persons and organizations concerned by the topic.

### ACCESSIBILITY
