

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of November 26, 2013:

13-031-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement autorisant la démolition de l'église Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix ainsi que la construction et l'occupation d'une ressource intermédiaire sur le lot 1 153 010 (13-031)

[By-law amending the By-law authorizing the demolition of Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix church as well as the construction and occupancy of an intermediate resource on lot 1 153 010 (13-031)]

08-046-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la rémunération des membres indépendants du comité de vérification (08-046)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the remuneration of independent members of the audit committee (08-046)]

The object is to increase the remuneration of independent members of the audit committee. The remuneration may not exceed, on an annual basis, \$22,500 for the chair, and \$17,500 for a member.

12-049-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement relatif à la cession pour fins d'établissement, de maintien et d'amélioration de parcs, de terrains de jeux et de préservation d'espaces naturels sur le territoire de l'arrondissement du Plateau-Mont-Royal (12-049)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the transfer for the purposes of establishing, maintaining and improving parks and playgrounds, and of preserving natural areas on the territory of Plateau-Mont-Royal borough (12-049)]

The object is to render mandatory the contribution to the park fund upon creation of a co-ownership and to exempt from the application of the by-law all projects for the conversion of an existing building through the addition of one or two dwelling units.
