Improving taxi drivers' safety as well as the taxi transportation service in the urban agglomeration of Montréal

The standing committee on transportation and public works will consult the city's population with respect to ways of improving taxi drivers' safety, as well as the taxi transportation service in the urban agglomeration of Montréal.

At its first public meeting, to be held on April 15, 2014, the management of the Bureau du taxi de Montréal, along with that of the Service de police de la Ville de Montréal, will outline the safety issues inherent to the taxi industry. They will also present an analysis of the needs and expectations of both taxi drivers, and of the users of this means of transportation in the urban agglomeration of Montréal. Furthermore, the preliminary findings concerning necessary safety measures will be revealed.

Moreover, committee members wish for this public review to provide a platform for fruitful exchanges and for the exploration of future solutions, in conjunction with industry representatives and the Service de police de la Ville de Montréal. They thus extend the invitation to citizens and representatives of organizations to participate in these public meetings, to be held as follows:
