PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

***Three proposed amendments to the Development Plan
of the former Communauté urbaine de Montréal***

At its meeting of August 29, 2013, the urban agglomeration council adopted draft by-laws P-RCG 13-016, P-RCG 13-017 and P-RCG 13-018 amending the Land Use Planning and Development Plan of Montréal. These three draft by-laws have a localized scope on the city's urban agglomeration territory.

- Draft by-law P-RCG 13-016 consists **of integrating the longitudinal profile of the St. Lawrence river, Varennes-Grondines segment**, applicable to the east end of the territory of Rivière-des-Prairies—Pointe-aux-Trembles borough.
- Draft by-law P-RCG 13-017 consists **of adding a derogation to the floodplain in the marsh area of the Parc-nature de la Pointe-aux-Prairies**, located on the territory of Rivière-des-Prairies—Pointe-aux-Trembles borough.
- Draft by-law P-RCG 13-018 consists **of adding a derogation to the floodplain in the Boulevard Lalande area** located on the territory of Pierrefonds-Roxboro borough.

At the public meeting to be held on June 11, 2014, the Commission sur le schéma d'aménagement et de développement de Montréal (standing committee on the Land Use Planning and Development Plan of Montréal) will explain the proposed amendments and, as the case may be, its effects on urban planning by-laws in boroughs. Citizens and representatives of organizations are invited to participate in this public meeting, scheduled to take place as follows:

- DATE** Wednesday, June 11, 2014 – Presentation of the three (3) draft by-laws and public question and comment period
- PLACE** City hall, council chamber, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est / Champ-de-Mars metro stm.info

ACCESSIBILITY (CITY HALL)

Persons with reduced mobility may access city hall using the west side entrance (Place Vauquelin). The room is equipped with a hearing aid system that can be accessed by tuning in to 100.3 FM on your portable player. Moreover, an interpretation service for persons with a hearing disability may be available on request, subject to the availability of interpreters.

Citizens and organization representatives who wish to speak during the public question and comment period should register during the 30 minutes preceding the meeting, or contact the Service du greffe as of today. Please note that registration is not required in order to attend public meetings. Only those wishing to speak need register.

Documents regarding this public meeting, including the three draft by-laws, the three explanatory documents pertaining to the nature of the amendments to be made by Rivière-des-Prairies—Pointe-aux-Trembles and Pierrefonds-Roxboro boroughs to their urban planning by-laws in order to conform with the amended Development Plan, and the resolutions whereby they were adopted, are available for consultation at Accès Montréal offices, borough offices and city halls, at the Service du greffe, and online at: ville.montreal.qc.ca/commissions.
