

**COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

**Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of May 1, 2014:**

**RCG 14-017 Règlement sur les subventions relatives aux bâtiments affectés à des activités d'économie sociale (Programme Réussir@Montréal - Économie sociale) et modifiant le Règlement du conseil d'agglomération sur la définition de l'aide à l'entreprise (RCG 06-019)**  
[By-law concerning subsidies for buildings used for social economy activities (Réussir@Montréal – Social Economy Program) and amending the By-law of the urban agglomeration council concerning business assistance (RCG 06-019)]

The object is to create a new subsidy program for renovation, expansion and construction work, for the installation or changing of signs, as well as for professional fees directly related to such work. The by-law also amends by-law RCG 06-019 by specifically removing social economy businesses from exclusions from the definition business assistance.
