

## Public notice



### ORDINANCE

NOTICE is hereby given that the following ordinance was adopted by the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council at its regular meeting on March 3, 2014, and forwarded to the Minister of Transport along with an information and signage plan. Since the Minister has not published a notice of disallowance in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*, this ordinance came into force on June 2, 2014, i.e. 90 days after its adoption, in accordance with section 626 of the *Highway Safety Code* (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2).

BY-LAW CONCERNING TRAFFIC AND PARKING (R.B.C.M., c. C-4.1, article 3, paragraph 9)

- Ordinance allowing the establishment of a 40 km/h zone on avenue Earnscliffe for a distance of 75 metres northward, starting 0 metres north of rue Snowdon.
