

## **PUBLIC NOTICE COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of March 27, 2014:

- RCG 14-009** By-law approving amendments 3, 4, 5 and 6 to the **Règlement du Régime de rentes des policiers de la Communauté urbaine de Montréal (Règlement 1978)**
- RCG 14-010** By-law approving amendments 2, 3, 4 and 5 to the **Règlement du Régime de rentes des policiers et policières de la Communauté urbaine de Montréal (1992) du 22 juin 1995 (Règlement 1992)**
- RCG 14-011** By-law approving amendments 1, 2, 3 and 4 to the **Dispositions du Régime de rentes des policiers de la Communauté urbaine de Montréal applicables aux policiers membres du Service de police le ou après le 31 décembre 1983 (Règlement 1984)**
- RCG 14-012** By-law approving the **Règlement du Régime de retraite des policiers et policières de la Ville de Montréal (1er janvier 2004)**
- RCG 14-013** By-law approving amendments 2, 3, and 4 to the **Règlement du Régime de retraite des policiers et policières de la Ville de Montréal (1997)**

The object of the amendments approved by by-laws RCG 14-009, RCG 14-010, RCG 14-011 and RCG 14-013 is namely to integrate the adjustments to the police officers' pension fund required under the amendments to the Supplemental Pension Plans Act adopted between 1990 and 2012. They also integrate various improvements affecting retirees, ex-police officers entitled to a differed pension and spouses. The registration required under the Supplemental Pension Plans Act (CQLR, c. R-15.1) for the amendments approved by these by-laws was made by the Régie des rentes du Québec (RRQ) in decisions dated August 7, August 13, October 9 and October 10, 2014.

By-law RCG 14-012 concerns active police officers or those hired on and after January 1, 2004. It incorporates improvements resulting from the agreement

dated August 15, 2007 on the appropriation of actuarial surpluses. The RRQ registered the amendments approved by this by-law on October 10, 2014.
