

PUBLIC NOTICE
COMING INTO FORCE OF INTERIM CONTROL BY-LAW RCG 14-031

Notice is given that the urban agglomeration council adopted, at its meeting of October 30, 2014, the by-law titled “Interim control by-law regarding the protection of metropolitan woods and forest corridors (RCG 14-031)”. The by-law prohibits any new land use, any new construction, including any extension, as well as any application for cadastral operations and the parcelling out of lots by alienation in the metropolitan woods and forest corridors shown in schedule A to said by-law. It also provides certain exceptions to the general prohibition.

On January 5, 2015, the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy served an opinion stating that by-law RCG 14-031 is consistent with government policy directions regarding land use development. Consequently, that by-law came into force on January 5, 2015, in accordance with section 66 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1).
