Notice is given that the following ordinance under article 22 of the By-law concerning horsedrawn vehicles (R.B.C.M., chapter V-1) was adopted at the executive committee meeting of February 4, 2015:

GENERAL ORDINANCE CONCERNING HORSEDRAWN VEHICLES (Number 66)

The object is to group together in a single ordinance the provisions concerning the qualifications for a driver of a horsedrawn vehicle, as well as those concerning permits, routes and stands, the daily recording of hitch time and fee schedules. This ordinance repeals ordinances 32, 35, 36, 38, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 64 and 65 enacted under the By-law concerning horsedrawn vehicles (R.B.C.M., chapter V-1).
