SUBSTITUTE MEMBERS OF THE
URBAN PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Borough Council invites borough residents interested in taking part in the work of the Urban Planning Advisory Committee to apply for a position on the Committee, by submitting their name, contact information and reasons for applying.

Four (4) substitute member positions are to be filled, and the borough wishes to create a provisional list of candidates to fill any future vacancies for regular or substitute members.

The Committee's roles are to review and make recommendations to the Borough Council on any request relating to urban planning and development. The Committee also reviews and decides, during public hearings, on building demolition permit applications. The Committee has seven regular and up to seven substitute members, with renewable two-year terms. It generally meets monthly.

Any candidate for this position must:

- be a resident of our borough;
- have a good knowledge of French;
- be available for meetings and hearings, held in the evening;
- have knowledge of urban planning, engineering, development, architecture or heritage or have been actively involved in the Montréal economic, cultural, scientific, community or educational sector.
