

PUBLIC NOTICE COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 28, 2016:

- RCG 16-003 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 3 600 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux d'installation de toilettes publiques autonettoyantes**
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$3,600,000 to finance the installation of self-cleaning public toilets]
- RCG 16-004 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 1 050 000 \$ pour le financement de travaux de réfection, de remplacement et de réaménagement de structures routières dans le secteur du centre-ville**
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$1,050,000 to finance repair, replacement and redevelopment work of road structures in the downtown area]
- RCG 16-005 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 300 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de réfection requis pour la mise aux normes des écocentres existants, un emprunt de 750 000 \$ pour financer le remplacement des instruments analytiques ayant atteint leur durée de vie utile et un emprunt de 300 000 \$ pour financer le remplacement d'équipements désuets des stations d'échantillonnage de la qualité de l'air**
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$300,000 to finance repair work required for the bringing to standards of existing ecosystems, a loan of \$750,000 to finance the replacement of analytical tools that have reached the end of their useful life and a loan of \$300,000 to finance the replacement of outdated equipment at the air quality sampling facilities]

These by-laws were approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy on March 1, 2016. They come into force on March 8, 2016, and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est.
