

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of April 18, 2016:

- 02-002-24** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur de la Ville sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil de la Ville aux conseils d'arrondissement (02-002)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the delegation of city council powers to borough councils (02-002)]
This by-law delegates to boroughs the power to adopt and enforce a by-law establishing a subsidy program for the installation of sum pumps in immovables located in areas subject to floods.
- 16-034** **Règlement sur les subventions aux sociétés de développement commercial financées par le Fonds de dynamisation des rues commerciales**
[By-law concerning subsidies to commercial development associations funded by the *Fonds de dynamisation des rues commerciales*]
This by-law awards a non-recurrent subsidy to 3 commercial development organizations from the Plateau Mont-Royal borough.
- 15-091-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2016) (15-091)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2016) (15-091)]
This by-law corrects the fees for registration to unsupervised racquetball and squash activities at the Claude-Robillard sports complex.
- 15-040-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement relatif à la lutte contre la propagation de l'agrile du frêne sur le territoire de la ville de Montréal (15-040)**
[By-law amending the By-law to stop the spread of the emerald ash borer on the territory of Montréal (15-040)]
This by-law increases to 15 cm the minimum diameter required to obtain a tree-felling permit for ash trees and also extends the periods where ash tree wood can be moved.
- 15-063-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention relative au traitement des frênes situés sur des propriétés privées comprises dans des zones à risques (15-063)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy for the treatment of ash trees located on private property in high-risk areas (15-063)]
This by-law advances the start of the eligibility period for the subsidy program to June 1, and increases the maximum amount of the subsidy.
