

**PUBLIC NOTICE
COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the city council meeting of February 20, 2012:

12-007 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le régime de retraite des employés assujettis à une convention collective de travail de la Ville d'Outremont (No 1292 des règlements de l'ancienne Ville d'Outremont)

[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees covered by a collective agreement of the former city of Outremont]

The following by-law was adopted at the city council meeting of September 24, 2012:

12-036 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le régime de retraite des employés assujettis à une convention collective de travail de la Ville d'Outremont (No 1292 des règlements de l'ancienne ville d'Outremont)

[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees covered by a collective agreement of the former city of Outremont]

The following by-law was adopted at the city council meeting of July 4, 2013:

13-027 Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant le régime de retraite des employés de la Ville d'Outremont (1038-10, modifié)

[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of Outremont employees]

The amendments under these three by-laws introduce provisions concerning the division of assets and liabilities under the former Outremont pension plans and their merger with Montréal pension plans. By-law 12-007 concerns blue-collar employees (taking effect December 31, 2007). By-law 12-036 concerns professionals (taking effect December 31, 2007) and white-collar employees (taking effect December 31, 2010). By-law 13-027 concerns managers and police officers as well as professionals (taking effect December 31, 2007).

Retraite Québec authorized all the divisions and mergers referred to in by-laws 12-007, 12-036 and 13-027 and proceeded with the registration required under the Supplemental Pension Plans Act (CQLR, c. R-15.1) on May 18, 2016. All of these by-laws come into force on June 30, 2016, with retroactive effect, as indicated. They may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est and are also available at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements
