COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

Notice is given that, on the dates mentioned below, the following by-laws were adopted by the city council:

- 11-026 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Régime de rentes des employés de Ville de Saint-Laurent (1279)** – Meeting of September 26, 2011
[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees of the former city of Saint-Laurent]
- 12-021 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le régime de rentes des employés de Ville de Saint-Laurent (1279)** – Meeting of May 14, 2012
[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees of the former city of Saint-Laurent]
- 04-006-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le régime de rentes des employés de l'ancienne Ville de Montréal-Nord et de certains employés dont est doté l'arrondissement de Montréal-Nord (04-006)** – Meeting of January 28, 2013

The amendments under these four by-laws mainly introduce provisions concerning the division of assets and liabilities under the former Saint-Laurent, Montréal-Nord and Saint-Léonard pension plans and their merger with Montréal pension plans. By-law 11-026 only concerns professionals while by-law 12-021 only concerns white-collar employees.

Retraite Québec authorized all the divisions and mergers enacted in by-laws 11-026, 12-021, 04-006-2 and 13-004 and proceeded with the registration required under the Supplemental Pension Plans Act (CQLR, c. R-15.1) on May 18, 2016. The provisions regarding parental leave contained in by-law 04-006-2 were previously registered on July 13, 2013. All of these by-laws come into force on August 8, 2016, with retroactive effect as indicated in the final provisions of each by-law.
