

**PUBLIC NOTICE
COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

Notice is given that, on the dates mentioned below, the following by-laws were adopted by the urban agglomeration council:

- RCG 07-026** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement intitulé Règlement sur le régime complémentaire de retraite des employés de la Ville de Lachine (2553-6)** – Meeting of October 25, 2007
[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees of the former city of Lachine]
- RCG 10-015** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant le régime complémentaire de retraite des employés de la Ville d’Anjou (1636)** – Meeting of August 26, 2010
[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees of the former city of Anjou]
- RCG 12-024** **Règlement modifiant le règlement intitulé « Règlement sur le régime complémentaire de retraite des employés de la Ville de Lachine (2553) »** – Meeting of November 22, 2012
[Amendments to the by-law concerning the retirement plan of employees of the former city of Lachine]

Amendments in by-law RCG 07-026 result from an agreement with the firefighter’s union and namely concern the composition of the pension committee. The Régie des rentes du Québec (now Retraite Québec) registered the amendments as required under the Supplemental Pension Plans Act (CQLR, c. R-15.1) on March 13, 2013.

The amendments in by-laws RCG 10-015 and RCG 12-024 introduce provisions concerning the division of assets and liabilities under the former Anjou and Lachine pension plans and their merger with Montréal pension plans.

Retraite Québec authorized the divisions and mergers and registered the provisions of by-law RCG 12-024, on April 7, 2015, with regards to the firefighters group and on May 18, 2016, with regards to the officer, blue collar, professional and employee groups.

Furthermore, following the public notice published on April 30, 2015 concerning the adoption, registration and coming into force of by-law RCG 10-015 with the exception of paragraphs 2 and 3 of article 1.1.6, Retraite Québec authorized the divisions and mergers concerning the officer, blue collar, professional and employee groups and registered the amendments of paragraphs 2 and 3 of article 1.1.6, on May 18, 2016.

By-laws RCG 07-026, RCG 12-024 as well as paragraphs 2 and 3 of article 1.1.6 of by-law RCG 10-015 come into force on August 15, 2016, with retroactive effect as indicated in the final provisions of each by-law.
