THE BOROUGH COUNCIL ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

ARTICLE 1 By-law 1049 of the Ville de Pierrefonds is hereby repealed.

ARTICLE 2 By-law 93-554 of the Ville de Roxboro is hereby repealed.
