

DRAFT BY-LAW CONCERNING THE TAX CONCERNING SERVICES (2017 FISCAL YEAR)

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that the draft *By-law concerning the tax concerning services* (2017 fiscal year) will be tabled for adoption at the Borough Council meeting to be held at **7 p.m. on Monday, December 5, 2016, at Centre culturel de Notre-Dame-de-Grâce, 6400, avenue de Monkland, Montréal**;

THAT this draft by-law provides, as of the date it takes effect, that a special tax concerning services of \$0.0462 per \$100 of valuation will be levied on the taxable value of any immovable entered on the property assessment roll and located in the borough, and that this rate may subsequently be adjusted;

THAT just as in 2016, the adoption of this by-law result in a transfer to the boroughs (special tax) of this portion of the fiscal space initially collected by the Ville de Montréal (general tax), so that boroughs can use this amount locally according to their needs and conditions;

THAT this draft by-law and related report (in French) are available for consultation at the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Accès Montréal office, at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground floor, from Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. A copy of the draft by-law may be obtained, free of charge, by anyone who so requests.
