



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of November 21, 2016:

- 16-064 Règlement autorisant l'occupation du bâtiment situé au 2450, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine**  
[By-law authorizing the occupancy of the building located at 2450, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine]
- 16-037 Règlement autorisant et encadrant la construction et l'occupation d'un ensemble résidentiel aux 1980 et 2080, boulevard René-Lévesque**  
[By-law authorizing and regulating the construction and occupancy of a residential complex at 1980 and 2080, boulevard René-Lévesque]
- 14-049-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement relatif à la cession pour fins d'établissement, de maintien et d'amélioration de parcs, de terrains de jeux et de préservation d'espaces naturels sur le territoire de l'arrondissement de Côte-des-Neiges–Notre-Dame-de-Grâce (14-049)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the transfer for the purposes of establishing, maintaining and improving parks and playgrounds and of preserving natural areas on the territory of Côte-des-Neiges–Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough (14-049)]  
This by-law exempts from the application of by-law 14-049 projects where the main use is for public or institutional facilities.
