

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of November 21, 2016:

04-047-173 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law amends the map titled "Land use designation" for Ville-Marie borough in order for the entire site of the immovables located at 1980 to 2080, boulevard René-Lévesque Ouest to become a residential sector. It also amends to map titled "Height limits" in order to bring the maximum height allowed in that sector to 65 m. (CM16 1289)

Following the public notice published on November 28, 2016 in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-173 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of December 28, 2016 and comes into force on that date.
