

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of February 23, 2017:

RCG 15-018-1 Règlement abrogeant le Règlement sur la subvention relative à l'amélioration de la sécurité incendie des résidences privées pour aînés (RCG 15-018)

[By-law repealing the By-law concerning the subsidy for the improvement of fire safety in private seniors' residences (RCG 15-018)]

RCG 10-009-4 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le transport par taxi (RCG 10-009)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning taxi transportation (RCG 10-009)] This by-law adds a mandatory vehicle inspection for every holder of a taxi owner's permit. It also includes details regarding surveillance cameras and GPS systems and confers a power of ordinance to the executive committee in this matter. Concordance amendments are also introduced to take account of the Act respecting transportation services by taxi.

The by-laws come into force February 28, 2017, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
