

**PUBLIC NOTICE
COMING INTO FORCE OF A BY-LAW AMENDING THE LAND USE AND
DEVELOPMENT PLAN**

Notice is given that at its meeting of December 22, 2016, the urban agglomeration council adopted, with changes, by-law RCG 14-029-2 titled “Règlement modifiant le Schéma d’aménagement et de développement de l’agglomération de Montréal (RCG 14-029)” [By-law amending the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan (RCG 14-029)]. The object of by-law is to add an exemption to the limits of the flood plain of the St. Lawrence River on the territory of Verdun borough, for the Verdun beach project.

On February 9, 2017, the Communauté métropolitaine de Montréal approved by-law RCG 14-029-2 and issued a certificate attesting its conformity to the metropolitan land and development plan (PMAD). On March 1, 2017, the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy served an opinion stating that the by-law is consistent with government policy directions regarding land use development. Therefore by-law RCG 14-029-2 comes into force on March 1, 2017, in accordance with section 53.11.14 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1).
