

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of March 27, 2017:

- 02-002-29** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur de la Ville sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil de la Ville aux conseils d'arrondissement (02-002)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the delegation of city council powers to borough councils (02-002)]
- 17-033** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil de la Ville sur l'occupation du domaine public (R.R.V.M. c. O-0.1)**
[By-law amending the By-law of the city council concerning the occupancy of public property (R.B.C.M. c. O-0.1)]
The object of by-laws 02-002-29 and 17-033 is to exclude the powers concerning the occupancy of public property and excavation work related to the installation of electricity, gas or cable distribution networks from the delegation to boroughs.
- 15-039-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement régissant la cuisine de rue (15-039)**
[By-law amending the By-law governing street food (15-039)]
The object of this by-law is to replace the rotation calendar for food trucks by an online reservation system. It also contains rules applicable to the occupancy of public property.
- 16-065-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2017) (16-065)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2017) (16-065)]
This by-law establishes new fees concerning street food permits.
- 02-002-30** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur de la Ville sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil de la Ville aux conseils d'arrondissement (02-002)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the delegation of city council powers to borough councils (02-002)]
The object of this by-law is to delegate the application of provisions related to the conditions for filing and issuing street food permits to the Ville-Marie borough, and to delegate to boroughs the application of the provisions of the By-law concerning street food (15-039), except for powers related to the selection process, the selection committee and the authorization of occupancy of public property for street food purposes, as well as the validity and expiration of permits.

The by-laws come into force March 29, 2017, except by-laws 02-002-29 and 17-033 which come into force on June 1, 2017. As of the date of coming into force, the by-laws may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est.
