



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of April 27, 2017:

**RCG 12-003-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal (RCG 12-003)**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the *Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal* (RCG 12-003)]

The by-law adds definitions, modifies the article concerning the maintenance and good working order of smoke alarms, integrates a table containing applicable standards, according to the year of construction or conversion of a building, and facilitates the identification of fire department connections.

**RCG 17-019 Règlement fixant le taux au mètre cube de l'eau en fonction des coûts réels relatifs à l'alimentation en eau potable aux fins de la quote-part tarifaire pour l'alimentation en eau potable (exercice financier 2016)**

[By-law setting the fee per cubic meter of water based on the actual cost of drinking water supply for the purposes of establishing the aliquot share for drinking water supply (fiscal 2016)]

**RCG 17-020 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les subventions à la restauration et à la rénovation des bâtiments à valeur patrimoniale et aux fouilles archéologiques (04-026)**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the restoration and renovation of heritage buildings, and for archeological excavations (04-026)]

**RCG 12-026-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Code de conduite des employés de la Ville de Montréal (RCG 12-026)**

[By-Law amending the By-law concerning the Code of conduct of Ville de Montréal employees (RCG 12-026)]

The by-law integrates amendments following a consultation of city employees, namely to facilitate comprehension and clarify the meaning of certain provisions.
