ADOPTION OF RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commission sur le développement économique et urbain et l'habitation invites citizens to take part in a public meeting for the adoption of the recommendations resulting from the public consultation that took place on March 29 and May 10 and 11, 2017, on optimizing the potential for economic development and innovation of institutions of higher education in Montréal.

This consultation gave us the opportunity to identify the major socio-economic issues and current challenges of the metropolis in the field of higher education. Twelve organizations, among which several institutions of higher education, as well as a citizen, presented a brief in order to share their point of view with the committee.

A public question and comment period will be held following the presentation and adoption of recommendations.
