

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of June 12, 2017:

17-068 Règlement sur la subvention aux artistes professionnels des arts visuels et des métiers d'art

[By-law concerning subsidies for professional artists in visual arts and in arts and crafts]

This by-law applies as of fiscal 2017.

17-055 Règlement relatif à la cession pour fins d'établissement, de maintien et d'amélioration de parcs, de terrains de jeux et de préservation d'espaces naturels sur le territoire de la Ville de Montréal

[By-law concerning the transfer for purposes of establishing, maintaining and improving parks, and playgrounds and of preserving natural areas on city territory]

This by-law provides harmonized rules for the entire city territory in regards to transfers for park fees, namely in the context of redevelopment projects. It will take effect on June 19, 2018, 12 months after coming into force, and will repeal, as of that date, former provisions concerning the same object, as indicated in article 19 of the by-law.

16-082 Règlement autorisant la construction d'un complexe immobilier sur l'emplacement délimité par le boulevard René-Lévesque, l'avenue Atwater et les rues Tupper et du Sussex

[By-law authorizing the construction of a building complex on the site bounded by Boulevard René-Lévesque, Avenue Atwater, Rue Tupper and Rue du Sussex]
