



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of August 24, 2017:

RCG 16-056-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement établissant les modalités de paiement des quotes-parts par les municipalités liées (exercice financier 2017) (RCG 16-056)

[By-law amending the By-law establishing the terms of payment of aliquot shares by related municipalities (fiscal 2017) (RCG 16-056)]

The object is to make the necessary adjustments to take into account the ministerial decree of July 21, 2017, amending the rules for calculating the agglomeration fiscal potential for the purpose of sharing agglomeration expenses between the related municipalities, from the 2017 fiscal year.

RCG 17-025 Règlement autorisant la modification de la station de métro Vendôme par la construction d'un nouvel édicule et d'un lien piétonnier jusqu'au Centre universitaire de santé McGill (CUSM)

[By-law authorizing the alteration of the Vendôme metro station by the construction of a new building structure and a pedestrian corridor to the McGill University Health Centre (MUHC)]
