



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of September 28, 2017:

RCG 13-005-4 Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant la quote-part tarifaire pour la fourniture de compteurs et la réalisation des activités déléguées afférentes (RCG 13-005)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the aliquot share for the supply of meters and related delegated tasks (RCG 13-005)]

The object of this by-law consists of replacing the fee schedule in schedule A. This by-law takes effect on October 15, 2017.

RCG 09-023-8 Règlement modifiant le Règlement d'agglomération sur la subvention à la modification du raccordement du service électrique de certains bâtiments (RCG 09-023)

[By-law amending the By-law of the urban agglomeration council concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (RCG 09-023)]

This by-law adds a sector of Rue Saint-Grégoire, in Plateau-Mont-Royal borough, to the scope of application of by-law RCG 09-023.

RCG 15-083-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les subventions relatives à la revitalisation des secteurs commerciaux faisant l'objet de travaux majeurs d'infrastructure (Programme Réussir@Montréal – Artère en chantier (RCG 15-083)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial sectors undergoing major infrastructure work (Réussir@Montréal – arterial roads under construction program) (RCG 15-083)]

The object of this by-law is to allow the executive committee to determine by ordinance the period during which by-law RCG 15-083 applies to a specific sector.

RCG 17-033 Règlement autorisant la démolition de deux bâtiments ainsi que la construction et l'occupation, à des fins résidentielles, pour des personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'hébergement, d'un bâtiment sur le lot 2 317 486 et une partie du lot adjacent 1 885 486 du cadastre du Québec

[By-law authorizing the demolition of two buildings as well as the construction and occupancy, for residential purposes, for persons in need of assistance and shelter, of a building on lot 2 317 486 and part of the adjacent lot 1 885 486, cadastre of Québec]
