Property Assessment Roll Applications for an administrative review

Notice is given that in 2018, the 2017-2019 property assessment roll of the Ville de Montréal will continue to apply for the second fiscal year.

In accordance with division I of chapter X of the *Act respecting municipal taxation* (CQLR, chapter F-2.1), any person having an interest may file an application for administrative review on the ground that the assessor did not alter the roll as required under the act.

To be admissible, application for an administrative review must meet the following conditions:

- Be filed in the fiscal year during which an event justifying an alteration to the roll occurs or in the next fiscal year, if the assessor does not make the alteration.
- Be submitted on the prescribed form, available at the addresses below and at any point of service of the Ville de Montréal.
- Be accompanied by the amount prescribed under the *By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (Fiscal 2017)* (RCG 16-055), adopted by the urban agglomeration of Montréal council and applicable to the unit of assessment covered by the application.
- Be filed in person with the Service de l'évaluation foncière of the Ville de Montréal, at one of the addresses below, Monday through Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4:30 p.m. and on Friday until 4:00 p.m.:
