ORDINANCE

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of December 20, 2017:

Ordonnance modifiant l'Ordonnance générale sur le stationnement des véhicules en-libre service (2)

This ordinance, adopted under the By-law concerning the parking of self-service vehicles (16-054), replaces articles 4 and 5 of the general ordinance no. 1 in order to set a new validity period for universal parking permits (January 1 to May 31, 2018) and provides for the renewal of the permits issued in 2017 for that same period. The ordinance takes effect on January 1, 2018.

Ordonnance émise relativement aux permis de stationnement universels (10)

This ordinance, adopted under the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2017) (16-065), reduces to \$550, as of January 1, 2018, the fees for the issuance or renewal of a universal parking permit for any vehicle that is not an electric vehicle.

Ordonnance relative à la période de validité du permis spécial de garde d'un chien de type Pit bull et à la modification de la définition de chien interdit et aux mesures transitoires applicables (7)

This ordinance, adopted under the By-law concerning animal control (16-060), amends the interpretation of "prohibited dog" in article 1 of the by-law by removing the Pit bull-type dog, renders inapplicable until their repeal or replacement the provisions of by-law 16-060 referring to Pit bull-type dogs and sets the applicable transitional measures.
