### PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

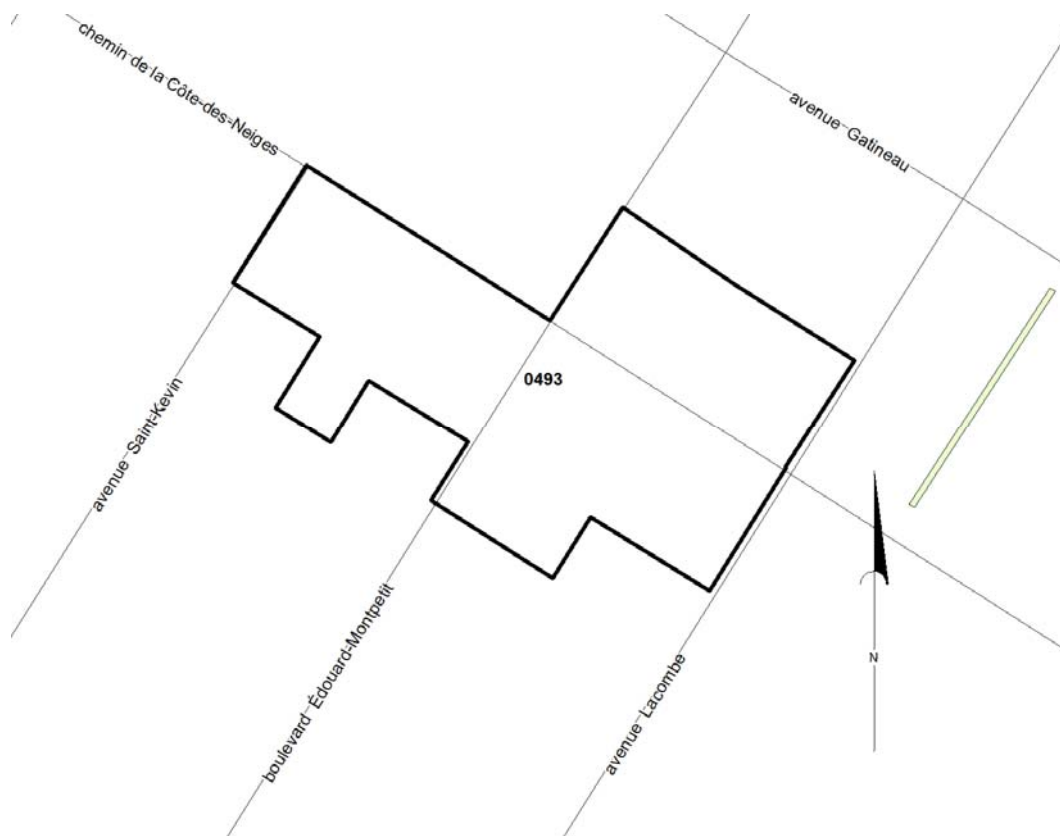
**Draft resolution CA18 170020 approving specific proposal PP-103 so as to authorize the demolition of the booth of the filling station and combine the properties at 5405 and 5431 chemin de la Côte-des-Neiges under the *By-law on specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable* (RCA02 17017).**

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that, following the adoption of draft resolution number CA18 170020 approving the above specific proposal PP-103, at the regular meeting of the Borough Council held on January 15, 2018, there will be a public consultation meeting on **February 5, 2018, at 6:30 p.m., at 5160 boulevard Décarie, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, Montréal**, in conformity with the provisions of the *Act respecting land use planning and development* (CQLR, c. A-19.1).

THAT the purpose of this draft resolution is to make it possible to combine two commercial properties, one of which has a fuel sales outlet located less than 50 metres from a lot occupied by shared or institutional equipment, an entertainment facility or a hotel and a coverage ratio of 20%.

THAT this specific proposal concerns zone 0493 illustrated below:



THAT in the course of this public meeting, the Chair will explain the draft resolution and the consequences of its adoption and will hear interested parties wishing to be heard.

THAT this draft resolution is subject to approval by referendum.
