

PUBLIC NOTICE COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of September 28, 2017:

- RCG 17-026** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 19 800 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux sur les collecteurs d'égouts
[By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$19,800,000 for work on wastewater collectors (RCG 17-026)]
- RCG 17-027** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 17 688 000 \$ pour le financement de travaux sur les intercepteurs de la Ville de Montréal
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$17,688,000 for work on the city's interceptors]
- RCG 17-028** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 25 260 000 \$ pour le financement de travaux et l'acquisition d'équipements à la Station d'épuration des eaux usées Jean-R.-Marcotte
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$25,260,000 for work and acquisition of equipment at the Jean-R.-Marcotte wastewater treatment plant]
- RCG 17-029** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 82 000 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de construction et de renouvellement de conduites principales d'aqueduc
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$82,000,000 for the construction and renewal of primary waterworks conduits]
- RCG 17-030** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 10 687 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de réhabilitation des réservoirs et stations de pompage
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$10,687,000 for the rehabilitation of the reservoirs and pumping stations]
- RCG 17-031** Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 18 613 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de modernisation, de pérennisation et de sécurisation prévus au programme d'investissement dans les usines d'eau potable
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$18,613,000 for modernization, durability and safety work under the investment program for drinking water treatment plants]

At its meeting of January 25, 2018, the urban agglomeration council adopted the by-laws listed hereafter in order to correct, in by-laws RCG 17-026 to RCG 17-031, the reference to the order concerning the rules to establish the fiscal potential:

- RCG 17-026-1** [By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$19,800,000 for work on wastewater collectors (RCG 17-026)]
- RCG 17-027-1** [By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$17,688,000 for work on the city's interceptors (RCG 17-027)]

RCG 17-029-1 [By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$82,000,000 for the construction and renewal of primary waterworks conduits (RCG 17-029)]

RCG 17-030-1 [By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$10,687,000 for the rehabilitation of the reservoirs and pumping stations (RCG 17-030)]

RCG 17-031-1 [By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$18,613,000 for modernization, durability and safety work under the investment program for drinking water treatment plants (RCG 17-031)]

By-laws RCG 17-026 to RCG 17-031, as amended, were approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy on February 16, 2018.
