

Public review of the event and feedback report for the 2017 floods

The *Commission de la sécurité publique* will hold a public review of the *Rapport d'événement et de retroaction: Inondations 2017 (Event and feedback report for the 2017 floods)*. Ms Louise Bradette, civil protection director, will present a review of actions taken by the city and its partners during the floods, across the urban agglomeration territory, as well as lessons learned from these interventions.

MEETING

The information session has three objectives:

- Inform citizens on the review of actions taken across the urban agglomeration during these events;
- Present the flood report and the evolution of the action plan;
- Listen to questions and comments of citizens regarding possible improvements to public safety and civil protection operations and that of its partners.

The presentation of the report will be followed by a question period for commissioners, and a public question period.

It is also possible to register 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the meeting. Please note that the number of seats in the room is limited and the order of the questions will be the same as that of registrations.

Representatives of the *Ministère de la sécurité publique* will also attend the meeting, in support of the *Direction de la sécurité civile et de la résilience*, to answer questions from citizens.
