#### **COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW RCG 17-036 AND OF ORDINANCES**

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Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of December 14, 2017:

**Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la réalisation de logements coopératifs et à but non lucratif (nouveau programme) (02-102) (RCG 17-036)**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the development of non-profit cooperative housing (new program) (02-102)(RCG 17-036)]

The object is to integrate the necessary adjustments to the Programme AccèsLogis as a result of the transfer to the city of responsibilities formerly handled by the Société d'habitation du Québec.

Notice is also given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of April 18, 2018:

**Ordonnance édictant la date d'entrée en vigueur du Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la réalisation de logements coopératifs et à but non lucratif (nouveau programme) (02-102) (RCG 17-036) – Ord. 1**

This ordinance, adopted under article 31 of by-law RCG 17-036, provides the coming into force of this by-law on April 23, 2018.

**Ordonnance modifiant la liste des cas admissibles à une subvention additionnelle et le montant maximal de cette subvention en vertu du Règlement sur la subvention à la réalisation de logements coopératifs et à but non lucratif (nouveau programme) (02-102) – Ord. 3**

This ordinance, adopted under article 23 of by-law 02-102, provides amendments concerning eligibility to an additional subsidy and the total amount of such subsidy, but solely for the purposes of projects whose preliminary approval has been obtained, but for which a definitive commitment had not yet been obtained by April 1, 2018.

**Ordonnance émise dans le cadre de la 21<sup>e</sup> édition des jeux FADOQ-Région Île de Montréal – Ord. 3**

This ordinance, adopted under article 118 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2018) (18-002), allows for the use, free of charge, of the Complexe sportif Claude-Robillard on May 8, 9, 10 and 16 for the above event.

**Ordonnance modifiant l'Ordonnance relative à la collecte des matières résiduelles pour le territoire de l'arrondissement d'Anjou (numéro 2) – Ord. 2-3**

This ordinance, adopted under article 18 of the By-law concerning collection services (16-049), amends Ordinance 2 with respect to the schedule for the collection of recyclable materials in Anjou.

**Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Vieux-Pointe-aux-Trembles » aux fins de l'application du règlement – Ord. 7**

This ordinance, adopted under article 4 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial streets (Réussir@Montréal - commerce program) (RCG 15-082), provides that the by-law applies to the designated sector as of May 1, 2018.

**Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Laurier Ouest » aux fins de l'application du règlement – Ord. 7**

This ordinance, adopted under article 4 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial sectors undergoing major infrastructure work (Réussir@Montréal - arterial roads under construction program) (RCG 15-083), provides that the by-law applies to the designated sector as of May 1, 2018 for a 24-month period.
