



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of April 23, 2018:

- 16-054-2** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement relatif au stationnement des véhicules en libre-service (16-054)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the parking of self-service vehicles (16-054)]
The amendments pertain to permits, namely by removing the minimums required concerning electric vehicles and vehicles for at least four passengers. In addition, schedule A is replaced in order to increase the service areas and Ordinance 1 is repealed.
- 18-002-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2018) (18-002)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2018) (18-002)]
This by-law takes effect on June 1, 2018. It sets the fees for a universal parking permit for a gas or hybrid self-service vehicle at \$770 as of June 1.
- 15-039-2** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement régissant la cuisine de rue (15-039)**
[By-law amending the By-law governing street food (15-039)]
The amendments namely concern rules for the reservation of spots and the selection of food truck operators.
- 18-002-2** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2018) (18-002)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2018) (18-002)]
The amendments pertain to street food (a. 15) and namely set the fees per period of operation, per spot, at \$30.
- 18-020** **Règlement fixant le montant des amendes à l'égard des infractions en matière de stationnement ou d'immobilisation des véhicules**
[By-law concerning vehicle parking or immobilization fines]
