



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-laws were adopted by city council at its meeting of March 26, 2018:

04-047-193 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law amends the List of buildings of heritage and architectural interest located outside areas of exceptional value for the Mercier–Hochelaga-Maisonneuve borough by removing the building at “2505, avenue Hector” from the category “Places of worship” and adding it to the “Public or community buildings” and “Residential buildings”. (CM18 0413)

04-147-194 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law amends the List of buildings of heritage and architectural interest located outside areas of exceptional value for the Rosemont–La Petite-Patrie borough by removing the building at “6274, rue Fabre” from the category “Places of worship”. (CM18 0414)

Following the public notice published on April 11, 2018, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), all these by-laws are deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of May 12, 2018 and come into force on that date.
