ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of May 23, 2018:

Ordonnance relative aux normes du système mondial de localisation (GPS) et du bouton d'urgence qui doivent être installés dans certains véhicules de taxi, au protocole de communication des données et à la plateforme pour la transmission des données (4)

This ordinance, regarding standards for the GPS and panic buttons that must be installed in certain taxis, as well as the data communication protocol and the data transmission platform, is adopted under article 185 of the By-law concerning taxi transportation (RCG 10-009). It provides, namely, that the holder of a taxi owner's permit must comply with the obligations under articles 62.5 to 62.7 of by-law RCG 10-009 and those under ordinance 4 within 6 months of this notice.

Ordonnance relative à l'autorisation de garde d'animaux de la ferme dans le cadre de la réalisation d'événements publics sur le territoire de l'arrondissement de Saint-Léonard (10)

This ordinance, adopted under article 54 of the By-law concerning animal control (16-060), sets out conditions concerning the keeping of farm animals during public events in Saint-Léonard borough.

Ordonnance relative à l'événement « Programmation printanière, estivale et automnale du Centre de la montage inc. – Les Amis de la montage dans le parc du Mont-Royal » (5)

This ordinance, adopted under article 8 of the By-law concerning peace and order on public property (R.B.C.M., chapter P-1), authorizes the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages with delivery tricycles during activities in Mont-Royal park, from April 15 to October 15, 2018, and 2019, and from April 15 to 30, 2020, between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m., at the locations and under the conditions indicated.

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Promenade Fleury » aux fins de l'application du règlement (8)

This ordinance, adopted under article 4 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial streets (Réussir@Montréal - commerce program) (RCG 15-082), provides that the by-law applies to the "Promenade Fleury" sector as of June 1, 2018.
