



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of June 21, 2018:

**RCG 18-023** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement 72 relatif à l'établissement et à la dénomination de parcs à caractère régional afin d'agrandir le territoire du parc-nature du Bois-d'Anjou**

[By-law amending By-law 72 respecting the establishment and designation of regional parks to expand the territory of the Bois-d'Anjou nature park]

**RCG 18-024** **Règlement du conseil d'agglomération sur la gestion contractuelle**  
[Urban agglomeration council by-law concerning contract management]

**RCG 18-025** **Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif en matière de gestion contractuelle**

[Urban agglomeration council internal management by-law concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee regarding contract management]

The object is to delegate certain powers under the Urban agglomeration council by-law concerning contract management.

**RCG 06-024-3** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les commissions permanentes du conseil d'agglomération (RCG 06-024)**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning standing committees of the urban agglomeration council (RCG 06-024)]

The object is to introduce a new form of public meeting, named "public discussion", as well as to increase to 10 the number of public meetings that must be held each year by the Commission de la sécurité publique.
