



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

**Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of August 20, 2018:**

- 18-041**      **Règlement interdisant les calèches**  
[By-law prohibiting calèches]  
This by-law, which takes effect on December 31, 2019, prohibits the transportation of persons on the public domain by means of horse-drawn carriages and sleighs. It amends or repeals numerous provisions of the By-law concerning calèches whose title becomes the By-law concerning stables.
- 18-042**      **Règlement sur l'encadrement des animaux domestiques**  
[By-law concerning domestic animals]  
This by-law replaces by-law 16-060 and all other provisions relating to animals in other by-laws, with the exception of by-law 17-079. It contains provisions relating to the types and number of animals allowed, required permits, the sale of animals, behaviour towards animals, nuisances and also introduces special provisions concerning potentially dangerous and at-risk dogs. The by-law takes effect upon coming into force, except article 23 which takes effect July 1, 2019 and the second paragraph of article 25 which takes effect on January 1.
- 18-002-4**      **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2018) (18-002)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2018) (18-002)]  
The by-law replaces article 16 in order to harmonize the fees therein with by-law 18-042.
