



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of September 20, 2018:

- RCG 13-004-3 Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil d'agglomération sur les délégations relatives au Règlement sur la mesure de la consommation de l'eau dans les bâtiments utilisés en partie ou en totalité à des fins non résidentielles (RCG 07-031) (RCG 13-004)**

[By-law amending the By-law of the urban agglomeration council concerning the delegations relating to the By-law concerning the measuring of water consumption in buildings used in whole or in part for non-residential purposes (RCG 07-031) (RCG 13-004)]

The object is to modify schedule C in order to add details concerning the installation of water meters without mechanical parts.

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of October 25, 2018:

- RCG 18-034 Règlement déterminant les territoires des parcs sur lesquels le droit de préemption peut être exercé et sur lesquels des immeubles peuvent être ainsi acquis aux fins de parc régional**

[By-law determining the park territories in which the city's pre-emptive right may be exercised and in which immovables may be acquired for the purposes of regional parks]

- RCG 18-035 Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif relatif à l'exercice du droit de préemption**

[Urban agglomeration council internal management by-law concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee regarding the exercise of the city's pre-emptive right]
